We have some exciting news to share with you!

This week, we announced a framework for \$264,000,000 to be invested into the local communities hosting the Empire Wind 2 project. This announcement is just the start of our dialogue—not the end. Equinor is excited to share this framework with local municipalities and the local communities and we look forward to beginning conversations about the benefits of the investment we are committed to making on the ground throughout the communities.

This framework includes over \$200,000,000 in tax generation over the lifetime of the project for the local school districts, villages, towns, cities, and the county, and provides an additional \$55,000,000 investment into the local communities to elevate community programs and facilities. We look forward to working with local municipal leaders to identify community needs and investments that provide support for a thriving community and provide opportunities for its residents. A portion of these funds are available in the immediate and we look forward in the weeks ahead to working with the local municipal leaders to identify projects to make impactful investments.

Additionally, we have announced a \$4,000,000 investment for a regional training and workforce development strategy. This investment will provide training and opportunities across Long Island, for the growing offshore wind workforce to become the leader for the jobs for our future.


